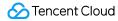



# **FTP Permissions**

There may be multiple projects running in parallel in the same Tencent Cloud account. To prevent information leakage between projects, for users who adopt FTP hosting source, Tencent Cloud can assign appropriate hosting source account management solutions with different permission to specific project and directory.

Note: Currently, FTP hosting source is no longer available to new users. Existing users can continue to use it.

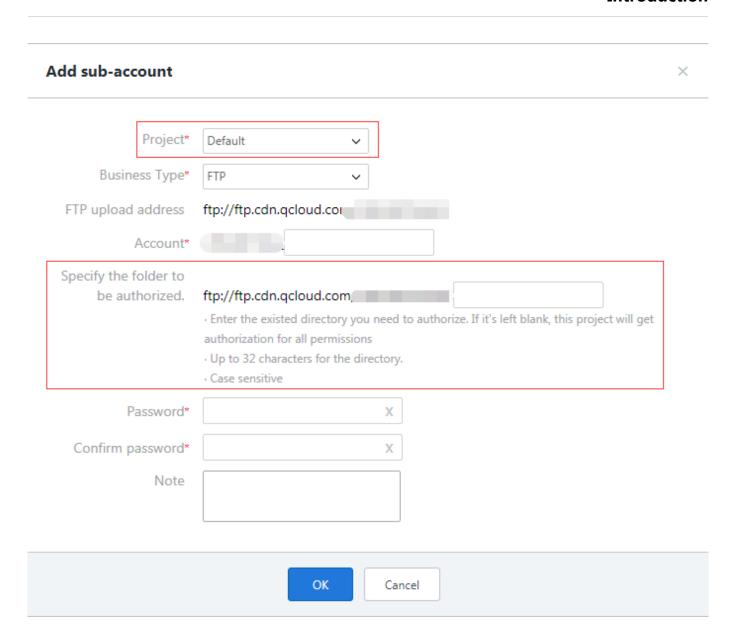

#### Create a Sub-account

Click + Add a Sub-account button to create a new FTP sub-account:

You can set the account info, password, authorized projects, and authorized directories of a sub-account.

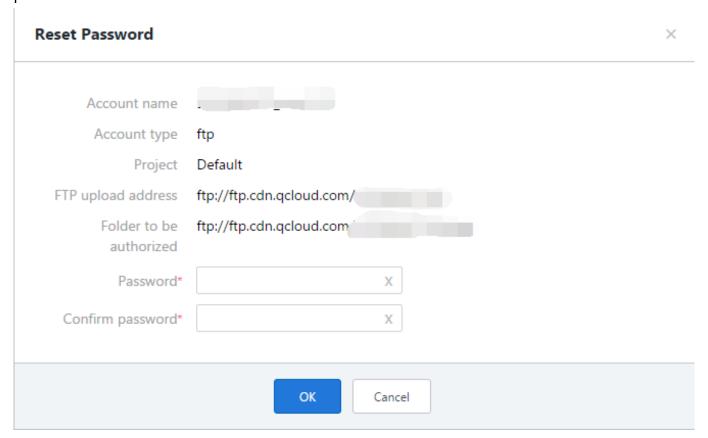
### Note:

- The account name is defined by the user with the cloud service account as its prefix number;
- You may not specify the authorized directories. In this case, you have granted all the permission to specified projects;
- The authorized directory must be an FTP directory that already exists; otherwise the subaccount cannot be added.

In the sub-account list, click Delete on the right side of the sub-account to be deleted. You should enter the password of the sub-account when deleting it:
